



2017 Adam's Vineyard Chardonnay

Adam's Vineyard is the newest addition to our estate portfolio. Planted in 2013, this 9-acre site is warmer than both Quail Hill and Susanna's, adding a unique Russian River Valley climate profile to our collection. A saturated golden hue is followed by deep aromas of custard, orange crème, pear and brioche. A luscious entry on the palate moves toward tastes of vanilla bean, wet stone and baking spices. The flavors of this wine linger all the way through the generous finish.
