The 2017 AMDG Pinot Noir celebrates Lynmar's dedication to excellence in our vineyards and winemaking. It also acknowledges the contribution of Jesuits efforts to bring learning and education throughout the world. A rich garnet color in the glass, this wine exhibits fresh strawberry, plum, and orange zest. Hints of cherry cream and spearmint intertwine on the palate with flavors of saffron and cassis. The textured finish follows with flavors of rich raspberry and lingering hints of forest floor.
