



2017 Monastery Pinot Noir

Crafted with a careful selection of Pinot Noir clones, our Monastery release is a nod to the wines of Burgundy. With an inherently earthy, savory character, this age-worthy wine's velvet richness is tempered by higher acidity and oak influences. A dark garnet color, savory elements of this wine are immediately apparent. White pepper, black tea, hibiscus flower and blackberry aromatics jump from the glass. A fresh, vibrant entry on the palate has hints of cacao, crushed stone, blood orange and plum followed by supple tannins in the textured finish.
